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One-Day Online Workshop on "News Writing Ethics"

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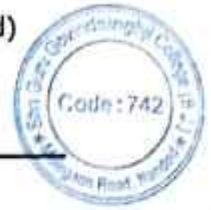


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Key Topics Covered:

- Avoiding Conflicts of Interest:** Prof. Kadam highlighted the significance of avoiding conflicts of interest, where personal or financial interests might influence news coverage. He provided examples of situations where journalists must be particularly vigilant to avoid compromising their integrity.
- Ethical Dilemmas in Reporting:** The workshop covered common ethical dilemmas faced by journalists, such as handling anonymous sources, balancing the public's right to know with individual privacy, and the ethical considerations in reporting on sensitive topics like crime or disasters.
- The Impact of Digital Media on News Writing Ethics:** With the rise of digital media, the landscape of journalism has changed dramatically. Prof. Kadam discussed the unique ethical challenges posed by social media, including the rapid spread of misinformation and the pressure to prioritize speed over accuracy.
- Case Studies and Interactive Discussions:** Throughout the session, Prof. Kadam presented various case studies to illustrate ethical breaches in journalism and how they could have been avoided. The participants were encouraged to engage in discussions, offering their perspectives on the scenarios presented.

Interactive Q&A Session: Following the lecture, an interactive Q&A session was held, allowing participants to ask questions and seek clarification on various aspects of news writing

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


ethics. Prof. Kadam provided thoughtful and detailed responses, addressing concerns related to the practical application of ethical principles in journalism.

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
